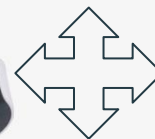




Home Screen

(Setup may not be exact)



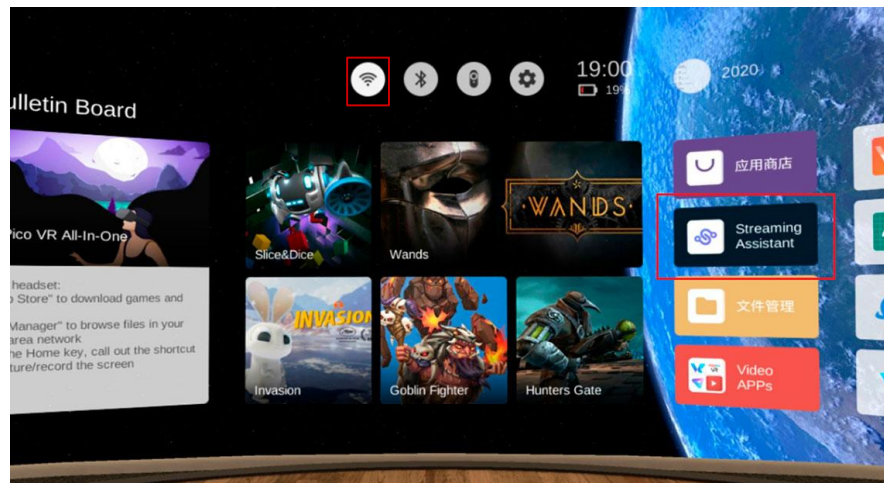

1. Click the Wi-Fi button on the top of the home screen (see image to the left).
2. Choose your Wi-Fi name and submit password.

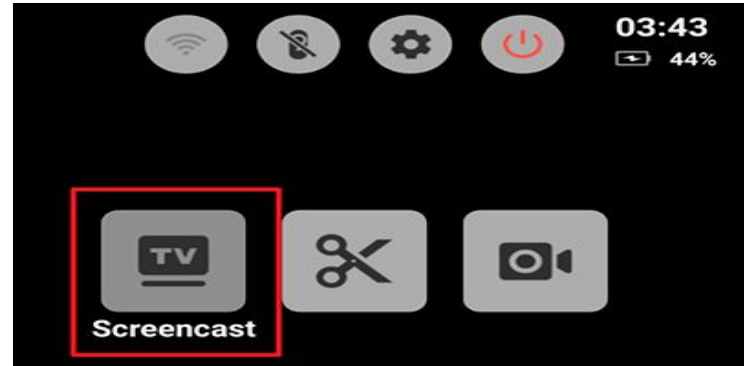


How to Display to TV

To cast screen, ensure your TV, TV box supports Miracast. Also, casting content from the VR headset to an Miracast-enabled Android mobile is also feasible.

To cast, perform the following:

6. Find Miracast application on TV/TV box, and make sure the application to start scanning.
7. Double click Home button on the VR headset to display the shortcut panel.
8. Click the Screencast button (see image to the left)
9. Choose projection device from the list.



How to Reposition Display

If your screen is not positioned to your ideal viewing, look at the position you would like to face, press and hold the HOME key for more than one second to re-center.



Project the VR headset to a PC

Ensure that the VR headset and PC are on the same Wi-Fi network.

1. On a Windows 10 PC, **select projection ==> connect to wireless monitor ==> project to this computer.**
2. On the VR headset, double click the home button of controller and click the TV icon to enter the projection screen
3. Click the three points in the upper right corner of project screen assistant to open the function of enable wireless display, select the corresponding device in the list, and input the corresponding PIN of the computer for matching to connect successfully.

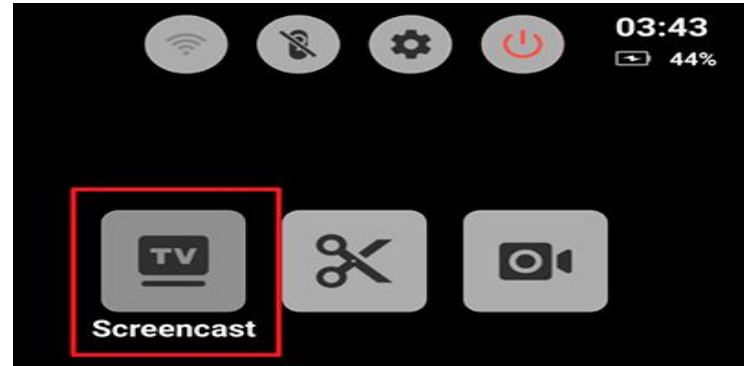


Project the VR headset to a Mac

Similar to your TV, download a screen-mirroring app supports Miracast such as Air Server™.

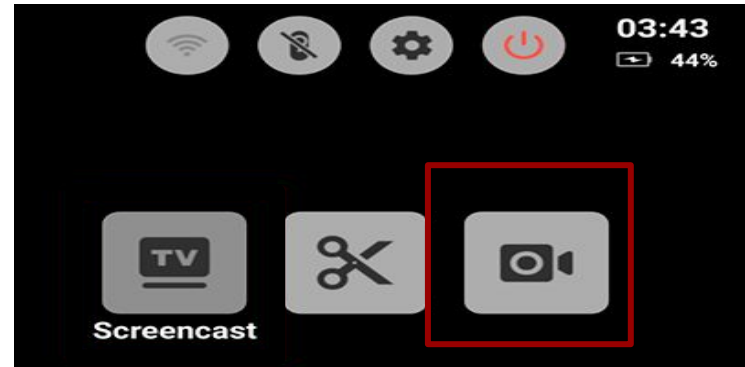
To cast, perform the following:

1. Open the Miracast-supported application on the Mac, and make sure the application to start scanning.
7. Double click Home button on the VR headset to display the shortcut panel.
8. Click the Screencast button (see image to the left)
9. Choose projection device from the list.
